

Dear Student,

Thank you for choosing Eden House College. We are confident that you will find your time with us to be both enjoyable and rewarding.

Students that are applying to come to the UK under a “General Student Visa” will need to show evidence of a minimum level of English (CEFR level A1). This means that they have some English, even if this is low level.

We ask that you send us just **ONE** of the following as evidence please. This can be sent by post, fax or email.

- A secondary school attendance record or leaving certificate showing that you have completed some English studies and for how long.
- A secondary school examination certificate showing some form of English language achievement.
- Attendance certificate from evening classes in English.
- A college or University certificate showing attendance at/achievement in an English course.
- An internationally recognised certificate in English (Cambridge ESOL exam, IELTS, TOEFL etc.).
- A reference from an appropriately-qualified person to state that the student has previously studied English, citing the course and dates and giving the referee’s contact details. It would be good if that person had also interviewed the student and can confirm their approximate language level.

You will need to keep the original of the above document to submit with your visa application.
